At the Children's Summit, which took place on 9th December 2014 in Copenhagen during the Handover Ceremony of the European Green Capital (EGCA) title from Copenhagen to Bristol, a request was made to amend the application form for EGCA 2018 to include a youth criterion. Following this, I discussed with colleagues how to best reflect the interests of future generations in the process of selecting future EGCA winners.

I can now inform you that the paragraph on Indicator 12 (Integrated Environmental Management) in Section 12.A of the application form has been amended as follows:

"Describe your activities and engagement with the different communities within your city with particular attention for youth participation.

Please reference any structures/projects/programmes that you have in place i.e. youth council, elderly citizens, disabled, socially deprived citizens; number of activities that were completed with different groups, the reach and objectives/impacts of these activities."
